

# Ukster cowl

## Description

Cowl for man – simple, classic, with non-itching yarn. Seems to be the easiest item to knit. And this one really is.

Male cowl in loop style – long enough to wrap it comfortable.

Made of sock yarn that is lightweight but warm and looks good with regular and even extreme use.

Pattern is very easy to knit and to remember. Stitch is reversible.

## Size:

One size fits all

## Yarn

Zettl Sockenwolle (48% cotton, 39% wool superwash, 13% polyamid– 218 yards (200m)/50g – 3 balls or any sock yarn.

## Needles

Size US 4 (3,5mm) 29" circular

## Notions

Stitch marker

## Gauge:

28 sts and 40 rows = 4" (10cm) (before blocking). Gauge is not essential but with different gauge final measurements and yardage will change.

## Abbreviations

CO - cast on  
BO - bind off  
St(s) – stitch (es)  
K - knit  
p - purl  
rnd – round

## Pattern notes

Cowl is worked in the rnd, and is easy to adjust by casting on more or less sts and knitting more or less pattern repeats.

## Pattern

CO 250 sts place marker and join to work in rnd be careful not to twist

**Rnd 1:** \*1k, 1p\* - repeat to marker

**Rnd 2:** k all sts

**Rnd 3:** same as rnd 1


**Rnd 4:** same as rnd 2

**Rnd 5:** p all sts

**Rnd 6:** k all sts

**Rnd 7:** p all sts

**Rnd 8:** k all sts



Repeat these 8 rnds 15 times (as in sample) or as many as you wish.

## Finishing instructions

BO loosely all sts and block the cowl.

The sample measurements are 26" (65 cm) length and 15" (39cm) width after blocking.
